We finished the alphabet this week and began doing some fall assessments with the children. Next week we will start our reading series which begins with a review of the alphabet. We are enjoying our new poem which will come home early next week; thank you for listening to your child read 😊. Our new sight word is the word "IS". These are great for building confidence in beginning readers; they are SO proud of themselves! We had fun this week listening to and role playing Brown Bear, Brown Bear what do you See and Polar Bear Polar Bear what do you Hear. These books have a repetitive storyline, which young children love and they can easily read. We are working on a class book Kindergartener, Kindergartener what do you See; to be coming home soon.

In Math we are learning about patterns. Patterns are the underlying theme of all of Mathematics and also a powerful problem solving tool. Early patterning work prepares children to see number patterns later on in their Mathematics program. Examine and discuss the patterns in objects around your home. For example striped material in clothing such as red, white, red, white.....beads in jewelry can have a pattern such as large, large, small, large, large, small.

In Social Studies we discussed Christopher Columbus on Monday and Fire Prevention the remainder of the week. The fire truck will be visiting our school on Oct. 19th !
