The children were introduced to "MORNING MESSAGE" this week; it is simply a message from me to the students written on the whiteboard. It is another activity to practice pre-literacy skills similar to our poetry journals. We like to expose the children to a variety of learning activities so they become confident readers and learners. Ask your child all about the morning message box....we have so much fun☺. We reviewed letters L, M, N, O, P and Q as well as learning about what comes first, next and last in a story. This is a great skill to work on after you read to your child! I introduced the children to WORD FAMILIES this week. We worked on our first word family....."AT". I hope you saw the slip-in-slide paper that we completed in class. Please have your child practice s-l-i-d-i-n-g down the sliding board as they

slide the sounds together to form words. These will come home whenever we learn a new word family.

In Math we are working on numbers 1-4, counting, formation and learning the number word as well. Please practice correct number formation at home. This can be very difficult for many of them!

We continue to discuss SPIDERS in Science, and how God made the animals in Religion. We also discussed Saint Frances as well!
