Please keep the little readables that I send home and have your child practice reading those. It is important for beginning readers to point to each word as they read. This helps with one to one correspondence between the written word and the spoken word. They will discontinue this on their own, as their reading becomes more fluent.

This week was basically a review week of ending sounds, words with short A in the middle, beginning sounds and letter recognition. They are becoming quite the readers and are very proud of themselves. Continue to praise your child and expose them to lots of reading

materials; they love to find popcorn words in books and are getting really good at S-L-I-D-I-N-G sounds together to form words. Once they build confidence in themselves; you will see such a love of reading begin to form. Keep practicing over break😊.

In Math we continue with numbers 0-10 and will start using ten frames in January to build on the number "10".

In Religion we have been discussing Jesus' birthday as well as Advent.
