

A Peek at our Week

Thank you for listening to your child read their most recent story, Nat is my Cat. We have been reading a variety of in class stories lately and they are really progressing. We will learn our next vowel sound next week; the short "O" sound as in octagon and op. Please practice this sound at home and have your child think of words where we hear that sound in the beginning of the word as well as the middle. We were also introduced to "inventive spelling" this week. This is a form of writing where the children write the sounds that they hear in the word. We talk about stretching out the sounds in a word like a rubber band. They might start out writing "hv" for the word have, however with stimulation and exposure between the child and a variety of literacy materials, they will eventually learn to spell it the correct way. You might want to have your child start to write as much as possible at home (and yes; by all means spell the word correctly for them if asked.)

In Math, we are finishing up 3D shapes and touching on equal and not equal parts of a whole. We are working on correct formation of numbers 10-20 as well. Please practice at home!

In Religion we continue to discuss Lent, as well as how Jesus is just like us. We stress what we can do on a daily basis to be more like him. We are also starting to read stories from our very own Bible that we can keep at the end of the year 😊.

We are discussing dental health in Science and learning proper care of our teeth. Ask your child all about it!
