

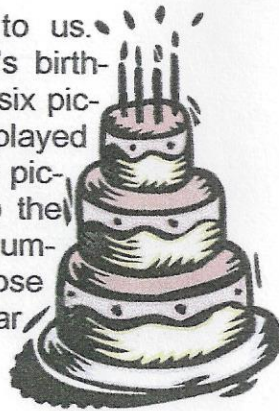
Snacks

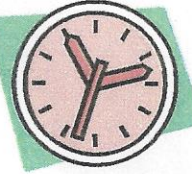
Birthdays
