

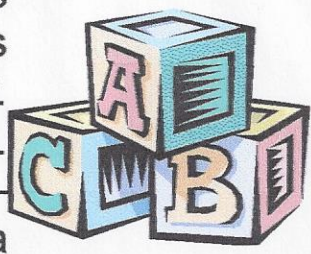


Classroom News
