- We participated in many following directions activities as well as listening activities, and tracing and cutting.
- We spent a lot of time discussing how to be a good friend and how not to be a good friend.

These are just a few of the many activities we participated in this week. SO.....when you ask your child, "What did you do in school today"?.....Perhaps this will help☺.
