The children have been introduced to nouns and verbs this year! Earlier in the year we touched on the meaning of a NOUN as a person, place or thing... this week we are working on VERBS. We role played different verbs such as swim, run, hop etc.. We learn so much in Kindergarten but have loads of fun doing it☺.

After Christmas we will start writing our first and LAST name on our papers. Some of the children are already doing this!

In Math we finished up graphing and probability and now we are working on place value (tens and ones). We do place value during our calendar time every morning using straws for how many days we've been in school therefore, they are catching on pretty quick to this skill. I also introduced the TEN FRAME... we will use this for the remainder of the year. It's a great tool for addition readiness!!

In Social Studies we continue with American Symbols and in Religion we discussed THE TRINITY, MARY and CHRISTMAS.
