In Math, we are finishing up Unit One. The children will be assessed on this Monday. Chapter two will cover different strategies, to compare numbers to five. How's the homework going? Any questions.....just ask!

In Science we continue with APPLES. We had a taste test using red, yellow and green apples, then we made a graph to show the results. We estimated how many seeds are in our apple, then we cut them and examined how close our estimate was.
