We are going to be learning the eight primary color words within the next few weeks. We will continue with TO, SEE, and A next week as well. I also introduced ENDING SOUNDS to the children this week. We learned how to slide and punch (ask your child all about it) to help us hear that ending sound. We also had fun reading BROWN BEAR BROWN BEAR WHAT DO YOU SEE? and comparing it to other Eric Carle stories. Children love the predictable text; they can easily read the book themselves because of that.

We finished up Chapter Two in Math this week and took the chapter test yesterday. Chapter 3 deals with representing, counting and writing numbers 6-9. The new vocabulary is being sent home today also. They are expected to be able to read number words one-ten, I have them posted in my room to assist the children. Please practice these at home!

In Religion we are learning all the different ways to show love to others. Starting in October, we will take the children to the Motherhouse to visit the Sisters a few times a month. This is part of our Religion Curriculum.
