Our story this week was Bunny Day. Our focal skill was sequencing and our new sight words are DO, ARE, THAT.....please practice. We are working on fluency, as we read aloud our little readables. They are getting there! I will also be introducing reading strategies next week. These strategies will help them to use a variety of ways to decode a word. For example..."picture cues" is one strategy. Looking at the pictures to help figure out a word. "Lips the Fish" is another; they look at the beginning sound to help them with an unknown word. Ask your child about the others next week☺.

In Math, we finished up the chapter on subtraction and will be starting to represent, count and write numbers 11 to 20. This will involve twenty frames, place value, addition and subtraction.

In Science we are discussing PENGUINS. Ask your child some penguin facts! In Religion, we are discussing prayer, and ways to pray. (They love when we have our prayer circle☺).
