Our Story in Reading this week was ABUELA. We continue working on sight words **HERE, GO and FROM**... next week our words will be a review of color words. Our focal skill for the week was **SETTING** of the story and we continue with the short E vowel sound as in elephant. I can tell there is **LOTS** of reading going on with your children at home. I see **SO** much improvement in decoding words and fluency! Way to go Kindergarten!!

We have been reading **DR. Seuss** stories all week in preparation for his birthday which was yesterday. We celebrated by eating **Green Eggs and Ham** and enjoying many activities. Today we played **Dr. Seuss Jeopardy!** To strengthen our comprehension skills...I asked the kiddos questions about the stories that I read throughout the week. Ask your child all about it☺.

In **Math** we began our unit on representing numbers to **20** and beyond. We are expanding our problem solving skills, writing numbers correctly and in the correct order, and counting by ones, fives and tens.

In **Social Studies** we finished up continents and **Where I Live**. We will begin our unit on **Living VS. Non-Living** next week. In **Religion**, we are discussing the meaning of **Lent**, ways we can make sacrifices to **Jesus** and the **Stations of the Cross**.
