

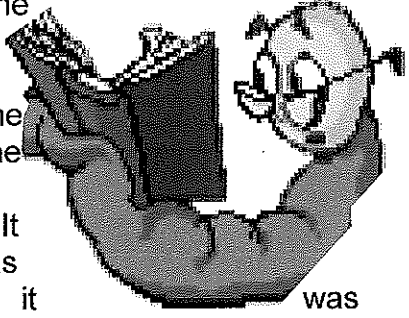

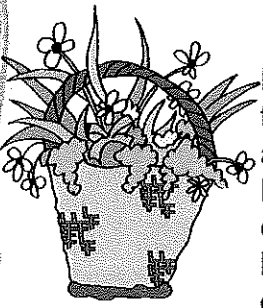
Summer's Almost Here!

Happy Mother's Day to all our Mothers and those who give Motherly love. The children have been busy making special gifts to present to

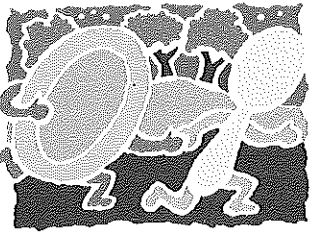
their mothers and are excited and proud of their creations.
