In Reading this week, we focused on the sound of letter M and our new popcorn word was AND. Next week we will review AND, I, LIKE and THE. We were also introduced to verbs, thinking through a text, using picture clues to help us with unfamiliar words and sequencing a story. We had fun reading a variety of Eric Carle stories this week. We learned similarities and differences in stories as well as a little about Eric Carle. They love the predictable text; they can easily read the book themselves because of that. We read books during our small group time with predictable text that coordinate with our reading series. They are SO proud of themselves!! I know you read together with your child daily....please continue to do that!

In Math we finished up chapter 3....representing numbers 6 -9 and took a test today. We also spent some time today practicing our left and right hand (please practice). We will begin chapter 4 which focuses on representing numbers to 10.

In Social Studies we are discussing Fire Safety (the firemen will visit us in a few weeks and bring all their gear)! In Religion we discussed the angels and how our guardian angel cares for us and protects us.
